## Divine Liturgy for Sunday, August 28, 2022 Twelfth Sunday after Pentecost

### **Troparia and Kontakia**

**Troparion, Tone 3:** Let the heavens be glad, let the earth rejoice, for the Lord has done a mighty deed with His arm. He trampled death by death. He became the first-born of the dead; He saved us from the abyss of Hades and granted great mercy to the world.

Glory be to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit.

**Kontakion, Tone 3:** You rose from the tomb, O compassionate Lord, and led us out from the gates of death. Today Adam exults and Eve rejoices, and the prophets together with the patriarchs unceasingly acclaim the divine might of Your power.

Now and for ever and ever. Amen.

**Theotokion, Tone 3:** Today the Virgin stands before us in the church and together with the choirs of saints invisibly prays to God for us. Angels are worshipping with hierarchs, Apostles exult with prophets, for the Mother of God prays in our behalf to the eternal God.

### **Prokeimenon, Tone 3**

Sing to our God, sing; sing to our King, sing.

**verse:** Clap your hands, all you nations; shout unto God with the voice of joy. (Psalm 46:7,2)

### **Epistle: A Reading of St. Paul's First Letter to the Corinthians (15:1-11)**

Brothers and Sisters, Now I would remind you, of the good news that I proclaimed to you, which you in turn received, in which also you stand, through which also you are being saved, if you hold firmly to the message that I proclaimed to you—unless you have come to believe in vain. For I handed on to you as of first importance what I in turn had received: that Christ died for our sins in accordance with the scriptures, and that he was buried, and that he was raised on the third day in accordance with the scriptures, and that he appeared to Cephas, then to the twelve. Then he appeared to more than five hundred brothers and sisters at one time, most of whom are still alive, though some have died. Then he appeared to James, then to all the apostles. Last of all, as to one untimely born, he appeared also to me. For I am the least of the apostles, unfit to be called an apostle, because I persecuted the church of God. But by the grace of God I am what I am, and his grace toward me has not been in vain. On the contrary, I worked harder than any of them—though it was not I, but the grace of God that is with me. Whether then it was I or they, so we proclaim and so you have come to believe.

### **До Корінтян Першого послання Святого Апостола Павла Читання (15:1-11)**

Браття! Пригадую вам Євангелію, яку я вам проповідував, яку ви і прийняли, в який і стоїте. Нею ви також спасаетесь, коли держите її такою, як я вам проповідував; інакше ви увірували надармо. Я бо вам передав найперше те, що й сам прийняв був: що Христос умер за наші гріхи згідно з Писанням; що був похований, що воскрес третього дня за Писанням; що з'явився Кифі, потім дванадцятьом; опісля ж з'явився він більш, як п'ятистам братів разом, більшість яких живе й досі, деякі ж померли. Опісля з'явився Якову, згодом усім апостолам. А наостанку всіх, немов якомусь недоносові, з'явивсь і мені; бо я найменший з апостолів, я недостойний зватись апостолом, бо гонив Церкву Божу. Благодаттю Божою я є те, що є, а благодать його в мені не була марна; бож я працював більше всіх їх, та не я, але благодать Божа, що зо мною. Чи то я, отже, чи то вони, — так ми проповідуємо, і так ви увірували.

### **A Reading of the Holy Gospel according to Matthew (19:16–26)**

At that time, a young man came and said to Jesus, “Teacher, what good deed must I do to have eternal life?” And he said to him, “Why do you ask me about what is good? There is only one who is good. If you wish to enter into life, keep the commandments.” He said to him, “Which ones?” And Jesus said, “You shall not murder; You shall not commit adultery; You shall not steal; You shall not bear false witness; Honor your father and mother; also, You shall love your neighbor as yourself.” The young man said to him, “I have kept all these; what do I still lack?” Jesus said to him, “If you wish to be perfect, go, sell your possessions, and give the money to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven; then come, follow me.” When the young man heard this word, he went away grieving, for he had many possessions. Then Jesus said to his disciples, “Truly I tell you, it will be hard for a rich person to enter the kingdom of heaven. Again I tell you, it is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for someone who is rich to enter the kingdom of God.” When the disciples heard this, they were greatly astounded and said, “Then who can be saved?” But Jesus looked at them and said, “For mortals it is impossible, but for God all things are possible.”

### **Від МАТЕЯ Святої Євангелії Читання (19:16–26)**

Того часу приступив до Ісуса один юнак і сказав: “Учителю! Що доброго маю чинити, щоб мати життя вічне?” Ісус сказав до нього: “Чому мене питаєш про те, що добре? Добрий є один тільки (Бог). Як хочеш увійти в життя, додержуй заповідей.” “Яких?” — питає Його. А Ісус до нього: “Не вбивай, не чини перелюбу, не кради, не свідчи криво, шануй батька–матір і люби ближнього твого, як себе самбо.” Каже юнак до нього: “Все це я зберіг із малку. Чого мені ще бракує?” “Якщо хочеш бути досконалим,” сказав Ісус до нього, — “піді, продай, що маєш, дай бідним, і будеш мати скарб на небі; потім приходь і йди за мною.” Почувши це слово, юнак відійшов смутний, мав бо велике майно. Тоді Ісус сказав до своїх учнів: “Істинно кажу вам: Трудно багатому увійти в Небесне Царство. Іще кажу вам: Легше верблюдові пройти через вушко в голці, ніж багатому увійти в Боже Царство.” Почувши це, учні здивувалися вельми і сказали: “Хто ж тоді може бути спасений?” Ісус глянув на них пильно й мовив: “У людей це неможливо, Богові — все можливо.”

- † God, cleanse me of sins and have mercy on me.
- † I have sinned without number, forgive me, O Lord.

### **Announcement about the Church Renovation Project:**

This is to inform our parishioners that St. Basil's Parish is taking the next step in the Church Renovation Project. The mechanical part of the renovation in our church begins after August 2, 2022 and will take a few months. During this stage of the Renovation Project, the heating pipes in church and boilers in the rectory will be changed. **During that process, some washrooms, the north and the south side pews and both crying rooms will not be available.** As always, seating will be available upstairs. The weekday 7:00 am Divine Liturgies will continue to be held in the church, however, you are encouraged to leave promptly afterwards, as work will begin at 8:00 am each day. Those who wish to continue praying may move to the Rectory chapel. The 9:00 am Divine Liturgy on Fridays will be held in the chapel, so space will be limited.

### **Renovation Funding Appeal**

As has been mentioned at the past two AGMs, the church needs significant repairs. Updated estimates were presented at the information session Feb 27, 2022, but these need to be confirmed by going out to bid.
