Announcement about the Church Renovation Project:

This is to inform our parishioners that St. Basil's Parish is taking the next step in the Church Renovation Project. The mechanical part of the renovation in our church has begun and will take a few months. During this stage of the Renovation Project, the heating pipes in church and boilers in the rectory will be changed. **During that process, some washrooms, the north and the south side pews and both crying rooms will not be available.** The outside structural repair has also begun and fencing is installed for your protection. As always, seating will be available upstairs. The weekday 7:00 am Divine Liturgies and the 9:00 am Divine Liturgy on Fridays will be held in the chapel, so space will be limited.

Renovation Funding Appeal

Our church repairs are in progress. The cost estimates have been updated through the tender process.

- 1. Structural Repairs – Priority \$750,000
 - a. Repair roof ties to vertical columns
 - i. North and South Columns
 - ii. East and West Columns

These are covered by the roof membrane. Perform with roof repair.
 - b. Install or repair mezzanine ties to exterior walls
 - c. Repair or reinforce horizontal beam connections to exterior vertical columns
 - d. Repair the cracks in the exterior walls
 - e. Roof replacement
 - f. Contingency allowance

- 2. Heating System \$1,010,000

Serves both Church and Residence. Proportional split between Parish and Basilian Order.

 - a. Boilers and Pumps and piping replacement. The boilers and pumps are purchased.
 - b. Air handlers and Fans replacement
 - c. Contingency
